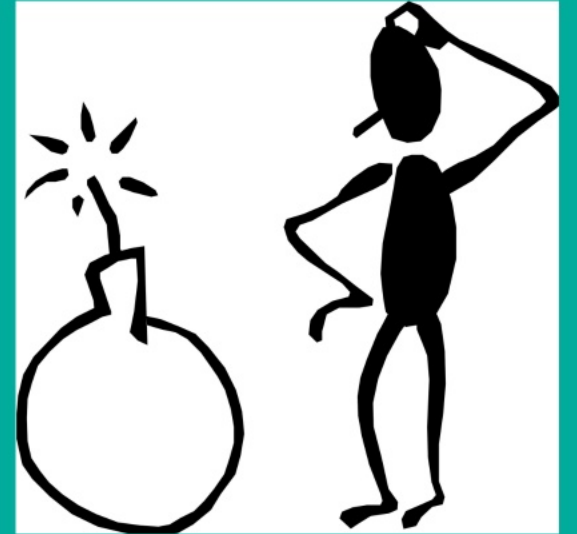

4. Implement a plan

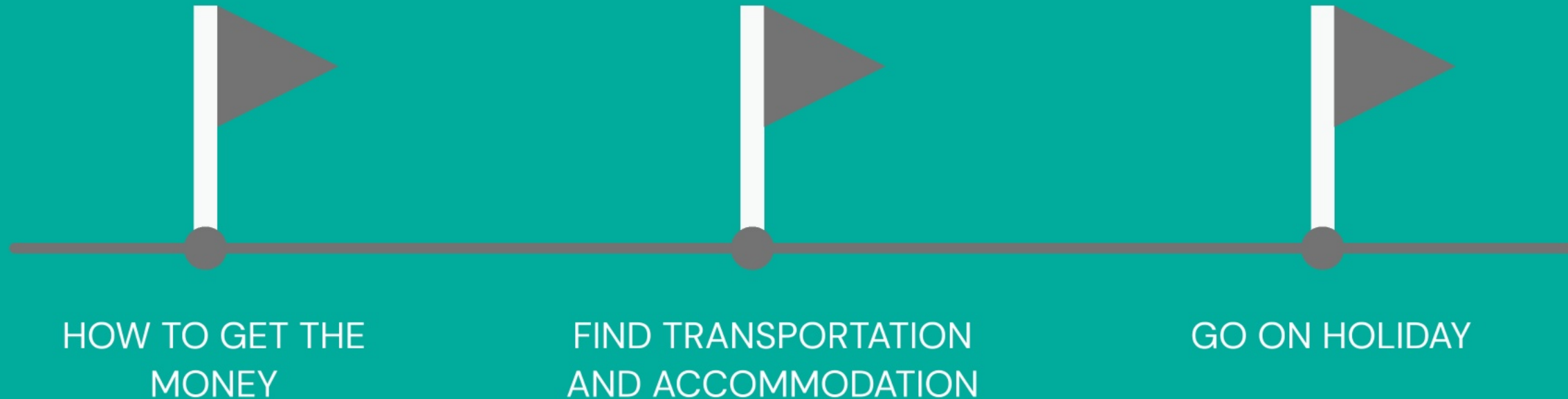


5. Evaluate outcomes

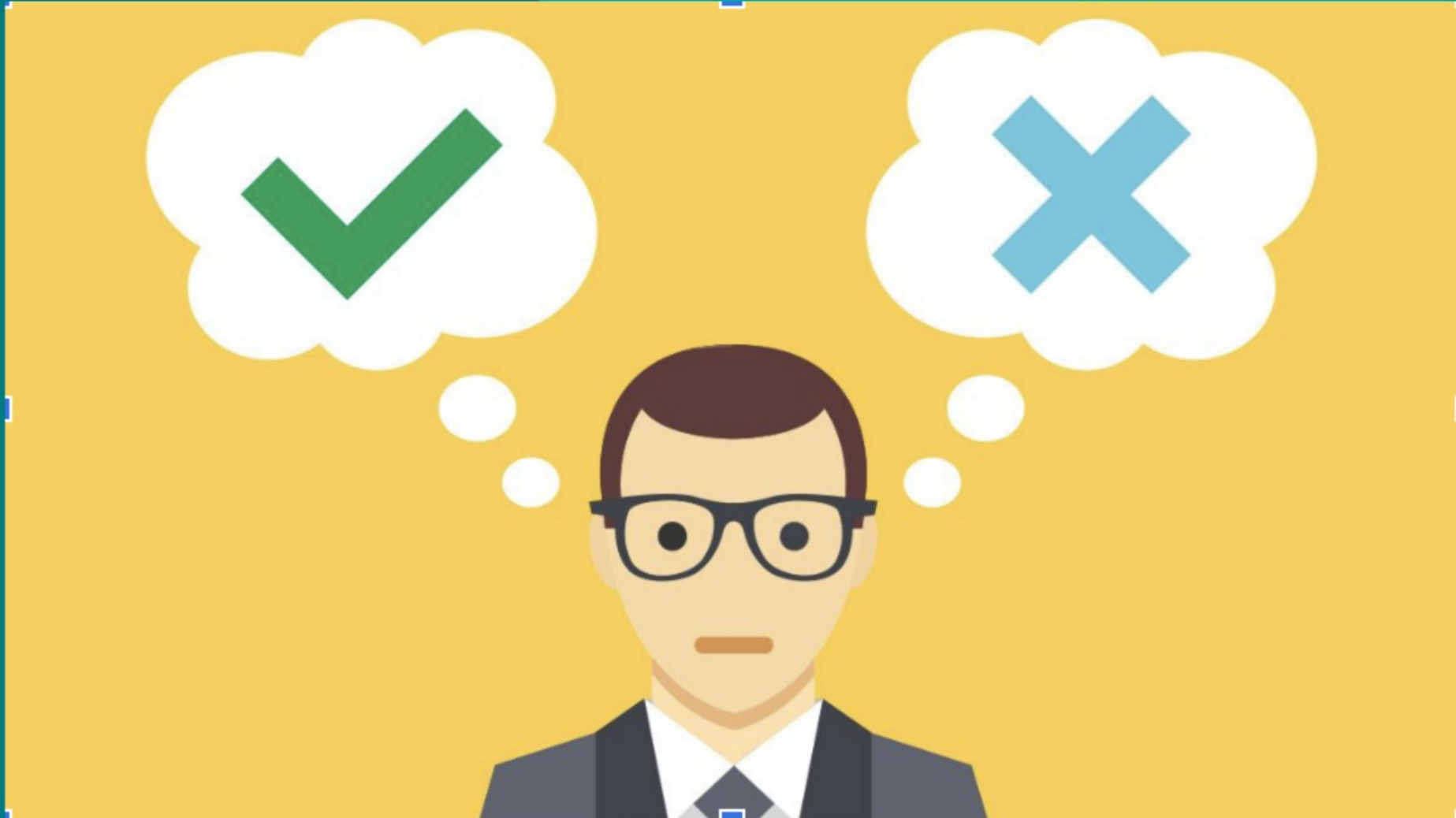

What do you do?

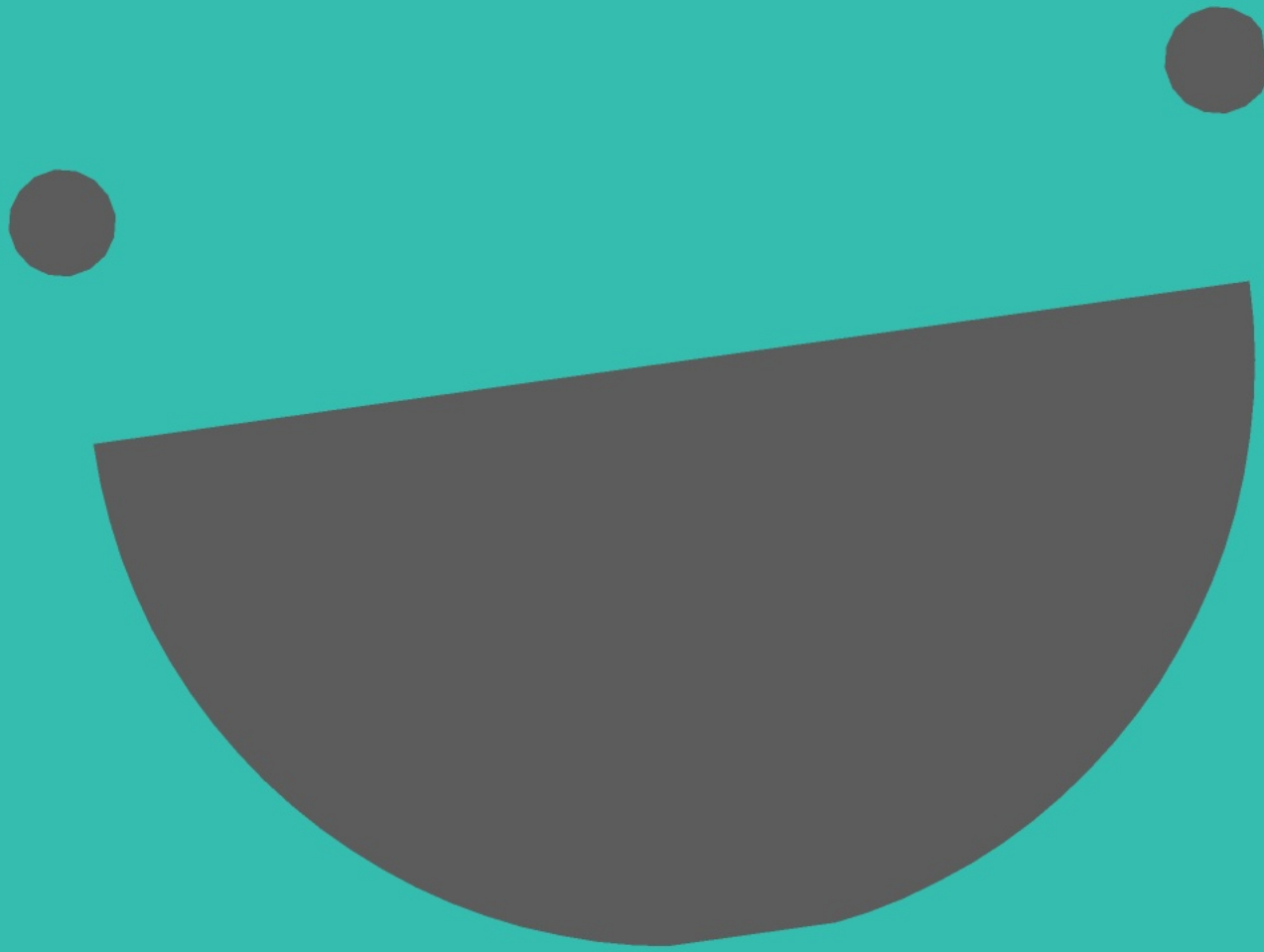
## Problem 2
